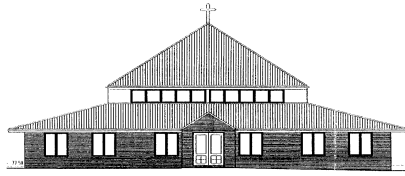

Mission 2013

Our final mission total for 2013 was **£2307**.

The first £2000 will be shared equally among our three nominated Missions;
The Willow Foundation, Diabetes UK and Mary's Meals.

The £307 above our target will be donated to **ASCEND**.

We also collected £384 for one-off appeals including the Syria and
Philippines crises. This makes a grand total for 2013 of **£2691**.

all those who came along to support them and help us reach this total. Our
new Missions for 2014 will be announced soon.
