

Lent is a very important time in the Christian calendar as we journey towards the Cross and Resurrection.

It is also a time of penitence and our Lenten journey begins on **18th February at the Ash Wednesday Service of Holy Communion at 7.30pm.** It is important that we observe Lent and the Ash Wednesday service is the best way to start. It is a beautiful service - please make every effort to be there.
