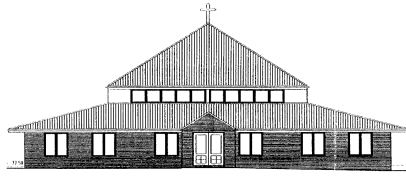

We shall be working with the Baptist Church and the Methodist Church to offer the training sessions. It will be very useful for all those who feel that they find it difficult to make ends meet, have concerns about managing their money or just need to think about the best ways to balance their income and expenditure. Everyone is welcome to come along and explore how their money can work for them.
