

REFUGEE CRISIS – THEY NEED OUR HELP!

No-one can have missed hearing about the refugee crisis which is emerging across the world. Millions of people are fleeing from wars in the Middle East to the safety of Europe. Men women and children have travelled for weeks - and even months - across continents and oceans to get the help they so badly need. The Diocese of St. Albans is currently working with refugee agencies to see how they can help and Watford Deanery also held a meeting to discuss our own response to this human tragedy.

We can do our bit by raising money to be used by Christian Aid who are working with the refugees. For the next few weeks there will be a basket at the back of the church for you to make a donation that will be sent off to Christian Aid.
