





Watford People's Climate March

Scientific evidence now overwhelmingly supports the view that climate change is the major challenge facing us this century. Over the next few decades our human well-being, the health of the earth and the survival of future generations are going to be really on the line unless we can halt global warming. The current rise in world temperatures is already having a devastating impact on many of the poorest communities around the world. The United Nations are meeting at the Paris Conference on Climate Change in November to agree a binding emissions agreement. People of faith across the world are on the move – walking, biking, sailing – and praying for the future of our planet.

Friends of the Earth are organising a peaceful demonstration to show the people of Watford and the world that we care about our local environment and our town, and that we want the leaders at the Paris Climate Talks to take climate change seriously, with actions, not just words.

Sunday 29th November, 12-2pm.
