

Have you been confirmed? Confirmation is the beautiful service when we confirm the vows which were made at baptism and when the bishop lays his hands on us and we receive the gift of the spirit. Children and Communion

It has been good news from the Bishop in that he has given us permission to admit children to Communion before confirmation. This means that we can admit the first group of children this Pentecost. Can you let me know if your child is between 7 - 10 years old (or will be 7 before this summer) so that we can have a chat about them beginning the teaching sessions in preparations to receive Communion. Children older than 10 (who will be 11 this year) can be confirmed later this year. **Thanks Pam.**

CHILDREN AND COMMUNION PREPARATION

Because of the strange Easter break for schools this year it has proved difficult to find a suitable time for the preparation classes and the service when the children will be admitted to Communion. However, we have come up with a new plan and would like to know what people think. The idea is to hold the service on Sunday 17th July - this would be the Sunday before the schools break up and would, I think, be a great way to end the term. The preparation classes would begin close to the beginning of June (sometime during the week from Sunday 5th June) and last for 5 weeks. We would, if possible, like to hold the classes during the week rather than a Sunday. We would like to know if people would be able to get the children to classes at church after school on a week day - starting, perhaps at 4.00pm - possibly on a Thursday. If you are parent who is interested in your child being admitted to Communion can you please let me know if this would work for you. - it is not written in stone and we want to make it work for all of us. Let me know what you think. Pam
