

REFUGEES NEED OUR HELP!

No-one can have failed to see on the news of the desperate plight of millions of refugees around the world. St. Albans Diocese is working to aid various refugee projects and in October the Revd. Tony Rindl, Vicar of St. Mary's, Watford, is taking donations out to the refugee camps at Calais. We will be collecting items for him to take out to France.

They have requested clothing for men (not women or children) - including winter clothing such as scarves, hats and gloves but also jackets and shoes, jeans, tops etc. If you can provide any of these items you can either bring them to church and we will take them over to St. Mary's or you can take them to St. Mary's yourself. Please think how you can help.

They will also be taking out food which has a long shelf life such as tinned and dried foods and this year our Harvest Appeal will be food for the refugees in Calais.
